Do you not say, that there are yet four months before the harvest comes? Look! I say to you; Lift up your eyes and view the fields, that they are white for harvesting.

1. So he said to them, that while there were yet four months left before the harvest, yet he was saying to them, that the fields were already white for harvesting. Thus he referred to the fact, that the opportunity was there to make disciples, and bring in a grand spiritual harvest, to the glory of God their father.

2. Then he said to his disciples; Yes, the harvest is great, but the workers are few. (Matthew 9:37)
