John 4:36~ Already the reaper is receiving wages and gathering fruit for everlasting life, so that the sower and the reaper may rejoice together.

1. Then he showed that the reaper, the ones sharing in the gathering in of this spiritual harvest, were already receiving wages for their work, to the end, that both the sower and the reaper might rejoice together in this fine work. The sower was Yehowah God who had started the Israelite system of things many years before. Together they would rejoice in a fine harvest of spiritually minded ones.

4. And the ones having insight will shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who are bringing the many to righteousness, like the stars to time indefinite, even forever. (Daniel 12:3)

**[Question]** What did Daniel state, that the ones having insight spiritually would shine like, within a world of spiritual darkness?

5. Now he that plants and he that waters are one, but each person will receive his own reward, according to his own labor. (1 Corinthians 3:8)

**[Question]** What will each person receive for working for this grand master, in gathering sheeplike ones during the harvest?
