

John 4:38~ I dispatched you to reap what you have spent no labor on. Others have labored, and you have entered into the benefit of their labor.

1· So Jesus told his disciples, that they were being sent forth to reap a field, that they themselves had spent no labor on in the past. Others had come before them and labored to produce this spiritual field, the nation of Israel, and even of Samaria. Yet here they were now, reaping from the fruits of other's labor in this field, like the labors of Moses and David, and of the prophets of God.

[Question] Who had been the ones to plant the seed, that they were now reaping?

2· To him all the prophets bear witness, that everyone putting faith in him, gets forgiveness of sins through his name. (Acts of Apostles 10:43)

[Question] What did Peter bear witness to, that all the prophets spoke about?

3· It was revealed to them that, not to themselves, but to you, they were ministering the things that **have now been announced to you, through those who **have** declared the Good News to you, with Holy Spirit sent forth from heaven. Into these very things angels are desiring to peer. (1 Peter 1:12)**
