

**John 4:42~**

**And they began to say to the woman; We do not believe any longer on account of your talk, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know, that this man is for a certainty, the savior of the world.**

- 1· **So after Jesus had been there for two days, the men began to say to the woman who had originally witnessed to them about Jesus, that they now believed, but not just on account of her talk. By now they had heard for themselves what Jesus taught, and they knew that this man, was for a certainty, the savior of the world.**

**[Question]** What did the men of the city then say, was the basis of their faith, and what did it show them for a certainty?

- 2· **Because the sayings that you gave me, I **have** given to them, and they **have** received them, and **have** certainly come to **know**, that I came out as your representative, and they **have** believed that you sent me forth. (**John 17:8**)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus later say about his own disciples and their faith in him as God's representative?

- 3· **And he proceeded to **say**; It has been more than a trivial matter for you to become my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to bring back, even the safeguarded ones of Israel. I also **have** given you for a light of the nations, that my salvation may come to be to the extremity of the earth. (**Isaiah 49:6**)**

**[Question]** For what purpose was Jesus send forth, and how important was his ministry in the overall scheme of things, within Yehowah God's overall purpose?

- 4· **She will give birth to a son, and you must call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. (**Matthew 1:21**)**

**[Question]** What was Mary told, that Jesus would do for God's people, and what was she to call him?

- 5· **The next day he beheld Jesus coming toward him, and he said; See, the Lamb of God, that takes away the sin of the world! (**John 1:29**)**

**[Question]** What witness did John the Baptist bear respecting Jesus?

- 6· From the offspring of this **man**, according to his promise, God has brought to Israel a **savior**, Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 13:23**)

**[Question]** Whose family line did Jesus spring from, and what did he become to men of Israel, who put faith in him?

- 7· Faithful and deserving of full acceptance is the saying, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. Of these, I am foremost. (**1 Timothy 1:15**)

**[Question]** What saying is faithful, and deserving of full acceptance?

- 8· In addition, we ourselves **have** beheld, and are bearing witness, that the Father has sent forth his Son, as Savior of the world. (**1 John 4:14**)

**[Question]** Why did Yehowah God send forth his son into the world?

- 9· Others were saying; This is the Christ. But some were saying; The Christ is not actually coming out of Galilee, is he? (**John 7:41**)

**[Question]** What lack of understanding, caused some within Israel to reject Jesus as the coming Messiah?

- 10· She said to him; Yes, Lord. I **have** believed that you are the Christ the Son of God, the One coming into the **world**. (**John 11:27**)

**[Question]** What did Martha express about Jesus, as her faith, in who he was?

- 11· So there came to be a great deal of joy in that city. (**Acts of Apostles 8:8**)

**[Question]** How did the people of Samaria respond to the preaching of Phillip years later?

- 12· So faith follows the thing **heard**. In turn the thing **heard**, is through the word about Christ. (**Romans 10:17**)

**[Question]** What does faith follow, and so what must be done to build faith?
