John 4:44~ Jesus himself, however, bore witness, that in his own homeland, a prophet has no honor.

1. Jesus himself however, bore witness to his own disciples, that in his own homeland, a prophet receives no honor, for people know him.

[Question] What did Jesus bear witness to, toward his disciples, about how a prophet is received among his own people?

2. So they began to stumble at him. But Jesus said to them; A prophet is not unhonored except in his home territory and in his own house. (Matthew 13:57)

[Question] How did men of Jesus home territory respond, when he told that that prophets are never honored by their own people?

3. But Jesus went on to say to them; A prophet is not unhonored except in his home territory, and among his relatives, and in his own house. (Mark 6:4)

[Question] Where did Jesus state, that prophets are never given honor?

4. But he said; Truly I tell you, that no prophet is accepted in his home territory. (Luke 4:24)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that prophets never receive from whom?

5. At this he said to them; No doubt you will apply this illustration to me. Physician, cure yourself. The things we heard as having happened in Capernaum, do also here in your home territory. (Luke 4:23)

[Question] What did Jesus state to the people of his home territory, when he could not perform many powerful works there?

[Question] What also was the true reason, why he could not perform them there, while he could perform them in many other places?
