John 4:45~ When, therefore, he arrived in Galilee, the Galileans received him, because they had seen all the things he did in Jerusalem at the festival, for they also had gone to the festival.

1. Now when he returned to Galilee the people there received him more kindly, for they too had gone to Jerusalem, and had witnessed all the things that he had performed there at the festival.

[Question] How did the Galileans feel, when Jesus arrived in Galilee, and why?

2. However, when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover, at its festival, many people put their faith in his name, viewing his signs, that he was performing. (John 2:23)

[Question] How had many of the Galileans come to put their faith in Jesus, while in Jerusalem?

3. Three times in the year, every male of yours should appear before Yehowah your God, in the place that he will choose. In the festival of the unfermented cakes, and in the festival of weeks, and in the festival of booths, and none should appear before Yehowah empty-handed. (Deuteronomy 16:16)

[Question] What were the Israelites commanded to do three times a year, no matter where they lived within Israel?
