**Accordingly he came again to Cana of Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine. Now there was a certain attendant of the king whose son was sick in Capernaum.**

- 1· So Jesus now returned to Cana of Galilee, where he had attended the wedding feast, and there turned the water into wine. Within that city there was a certain attendant to the king, whose son was sick but he was in the village of Capernaum.**

**[Question]** Where now did Jesus go within Galilee, and what had he earlier done there?

**[Question]** Who did he encounter there, within that city?

- 2· There were in company Simon Peter and Thomas, who was called The Twin, and Nathanael from Cana of Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. (John 21:2)**

**[Question]** Where was Nathanael from?

- 3· Now on the third day a marriage feast took place in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. (John 2:1)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus earlier attend in this city, and what miracle did he perform there?

- 4· Jesus performed this in Cana of Galilee, as the beginning of his signs, and he made his glory manifest, and his disciples put their faith in him. (John 2:11)**

**[Question]** What was the miracle performed at the wedding ceremony, the first of, and what did it make evident to his disciples who saw it?

- 5· When he entered into Capernaum, an army officer came to him, entreating him (Matthew 8:5)**

**[Question]** Who came to him while in Capernaum?

- 6· When, now, the director of the feast tasted the water that had been turned into wine, but did not know what its source was, although those ministering who had drawn out the water knew, the director of the feast called the bridegroom. (John 2:9)**

**[Question]** What quality of wine did Jesus produce for the wedding he attended?
