

John 4:5~ Accordingly he came to a city of Samaria called Sychar¹ near the field that Jacob gave to Joseph his son.

1· So he came to a city of Samaria called Sychar, which happened to be near to the field, that Jacob gave to Joseph his son.

[Question] Where then, did Jesus pass through on his way to Galilee, and where did he come to be?

2· Then he acquired a tract of the field where he pitched his tent, at the hand of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem, for a hundred pieces of money. (Genesis 33:19)

[Question] What field did Jacob acquire, and for how much, from the sons of Hamor?

3· As for me, I do give you one shoulder of land more than to your brothers, which I took from the hand of the Amorites by my sword and by my bow. (Genesis 48:22)

[Question] What field then, was later given to Joseph, the firstborn?

4· And Joseph's bones, which the sons of Israel had brought up out of Egypt, they buried in Shechem, in the tract of the field that Jacob had acquired from the sons of Hamor, Shechem's father, for a hundred pieces of money, and it came to belong to the sons of Joseph as an inheritance. (Joshua 24:32)

[Question] Where also was Jacob later buried, and whose inheritance was this?
