Jesus said to him; Go your way, your son lives. The man believed the word, that Jesus spoke to him, and went his way.

1. However Jesus was not of a mind to leave that area, and so he told the man to go home, for his child was now well. Therefore the man went his way, believing the word Jesus had spoken.

[Question] What though, did Jesus do, rather than to go with the man, and what did he say to the man?

[Question] What did the man then believe, thus showing his faith in Jesus spoken word?

2. Then Jesus said to the army officer; Go. Just as it has been your faith, so let it come to pass for you. And the manservant was healed in that hour. (Matthew 8:13)

[Question] What did Jesus also do remotely to the slave of an army officer without ever seeing either the army officer or his slave?

3. At that he said to her; Because of saying this, go. The demon has gone out of your daughter. (Mark 7:29)

[Question] What did Jesus also do, toward a woman's daughter remotely, without actually seeing her?

4. Elijah now took the child and brought him down from the roof chamber into the house, and gave him to his mother, and Elijah then said; See, your son is alive. (1 Kings 17:23)

[Question] What did Elijah do for a woman's son?
