

**John 4:53~** Therefore the father knew, it was in the very hour, that Jesus said to him; **Your son lives**. And he and his whole household believed.

- 1· Then the father realized, that it was in the very hour, that Jesus had told him, his son would be healed. Therefore he and his whole household believed in Jesus.

**[Question]** What then, did the father realize, about the healing of his son?

- 2· Then **Jesus said** to the army officer; Go. Just as it has been your faith, so let it come to pass for you. And the manservant was healed in that **hour**. (**Matthew 8:13**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell the servants of the army officer, due to the army officer's faith, and what happened as a result?

- 3· And he will speak those things to you by which you and all your **household** may get saved. (**Acts of Apostles 11:14**)

**[Question]** Who was Cornelius told by the angel to send for, and what would he speak to them?

- 4· But Crispus the presiding officer of the synagogue became a believer in the Lord, and so did all his **household**. And many of the Corinthians that heard, began to believe and be baptized. (**Acts of Apostles 18:8**)

**[Question]** Who was Crispus, and what followed his conversion to Christianity in Corinth?

- 5· **Jesus** turned around and, noticing her, **said**; Take courage, daughter, your faith has made you well. And from that **hour**, the woman became well. (**Matthew 9:22**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell a woman who touched the fringe of his outer garment and was healed, for what had made her well?

- 6· Then **Jesus said** in reply to her; O woman, great is your faith. Let it happen to you as you wish. And her daughter was healed from that **hour** on. (**Matthew 15:28**)

**[Question]** How did Jesus view the faith of a Syro-Phoenician woman whose daughter was demonized, and what did he do for her from a distance?
