

**John 4:7~** A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her; **Give me a drink.**

- 1· Now a Samaritan woman approached, seeking to get water from the well where Jesus was sitting. So Jesus asked her for a drink as she drew the water.

**[Question]** Who then approached Jesus, and what did Jesus ask of her, since she had a container for drawing the water?

- 2· Eventually he had the camels kneel down outside the city at a well of **water**, about evening time, about the time that the women who **draw water**, were accustomed to go out. (**Genesis 24:11**)

**[Question]** How did the servant of Abraham come upon a well, and what time of day was it when they watered the flocks?

- 3· At once the servant ran to meet her and **said; Give me, please, a little sip of water** from your jar. (**Genesis 24:17**)

**[Question]** How did Abraham's servant request water from Rachel?

- 4· Accordingly he rose up and went to Zarephath, and **came** into the entrance of the city, and, look! A woman, a widow, was there gathering up pieces of wood. So he called to her and **said; Please, get me a sip of water** in a vessel, that I may **drink**. (**1 Kings 17:10**)

**[Question]** How did Elijah approach a woman, and what did he ask for from her?
