

**John 5:10~** Therefore the Jews began to say to the cured man; It is Sabbath, and it is not lawful for you to carry the cot.

- 1· So the Jewish religious leaders seeing the man carrying his cot, tried to make him stop doing this, for they complained, that it was a Sabbath, and to carry the cot was work.

**[Question]** What though, did the Jewish religious leaders say to the man when they saw him carrying the cot around?

- 2· But the seventh day is a Sabbath to Yehowah your God. You must not do any work, you nor your son nor your daughter, your slave **man** nor your slave girl, nor your domestic animal nor your alien resident who is inside your gates. (**Exodus 20:10**)

**[Question]** What was the seventh day, to Yehowah God, and what must Israelites not do then?

- 3· And it came about that, as soon as the gates of Jerusalem had grown shadowy before the Sabbath, I immediately said the word and the doors **began** to be closed. I said further that they should not open them until after the Sabbath, and some of my own attendants I stationed at the gates, that no burden might come in on the Sabbath day. (**Nehemiah 13:19**)

**[Question]** What did Nehemiah do, to assure that the Sabbath Laws were lived up to in his day?

- 4· This is what Yehowah has said; Watch out for your souls, and do not **carry** on the Sabbath day any load that you must bring in through the gates of Jerusalem. (**Jeremiah 17:21**)

**[Question]** What did Jeremiah tell the people, not to carry into Jerusalem on the Sabbath?

- 5· At seeing this the Pharisees said to him; Look! Your disciples are doing what it is not **lawful** to do on the Sabbath. (**Matthew 12:2**)

**[Question]** What did the Pharisees accuse Jesus' disciples of doing on a Sabbath, though this was not wrong to do?

- 6· At this some of the Pharisees said; Why are you doing

**what is not lawful on the Sabbath? (Luke 6:2)**

**[Question]** What did some of the sticklers for the Law Covenant try to say Jesus' disciples were doing, by eating grain on the Sabbath, out of their hands while walking along?
