

John 5:14~ After these things Jesus found him in the temple and said to him; See, you have become sound in health. Do not sin anymore, in order, that something worse does not happen to you.

1· Yet later Jesus found the man walking in the temple, and witnessed further to him telling him, that now that he had become sound in health, he should sin no more, so that something worse does not happen to him. This seemed to infer, that the man had had a demon, and this caused him to be lame.

[Question] Who though, later encountered the man while walking about in the temple, and what then, did Jesus tell the man to do henceforth?

[Question] What did this infer, about why the man was lame?

2· Then it goes its way and takes along with it seven different spirits more wicked than itself, and after getting inside, they dwell there, and the final circumstances of that man become worse than the first. That is how it will be also with this wicked generation. (**Matthew 12:45**)

[Question] What did Jesus show would become of a man, who had demons if he did not take precautions against their return, and how could he end up then?

3· Then it goes its way and takes along seven different spirits more wicked than itself, and after getting inside, they dwell there, and the final circumstances of that man, become worse than the first. (**Luke 11:26**)

[Question] What does a demon do, when expelled from a man, where he earlier took up residence?

4· And, leaping up, he stood up and began walking, and he entered with them into the temple, walking and leaping and praising God. (**Acts of Apostles 3:8**)

[Question] What did a crippled man do upon receiving his ability to walk again, through Peter and John?
