- 1· So on this account the religious leaders went to persecuting Jesus, because he was performing healings on a Sabbath.**

[Question] What then did the Jews do to Jesus, because he had done such a fine work on the Sabbath?

[Question] What though, really motivated their distaste for Jesus?

- 2· But the Pharisees went out and took counsel against him, that they might destroy him. (Matthew 12:14)**

[Question] What did the Pharisees then take counsel to do to Jesus, over his fine works, for who were the people then putting their faith in?

- 3· Bear in mind the word I said to you, a slave is not greater than his master. If they have persecuted me, they will persecute you also. If they have observed my word, they will observe yours also. (John 15:20)**

[Question] What word did Jesus tell his disciples to keep in mind, about slave and their masters?

[Question] What did Jesus' words then foretell, for Jesus' disciples?

- 4· But in response, the presiding officer of the synagogue, indignant because Jesus did the cure on the Sabbath, began to say to the crowd; There are six days on which work ought to be done. On them, therefore, come and be cured, and not on the Sabbath day. (Luke 13:14)**

[Question] How did one presiding officer of a local synagogue feel, and what did he say, when upstaged by the miraculous works performed by Jesus on a Sabbath?

- 5· In answer Jesus said to them; One deed I performed, and you are all wondering. (John 7:21)**

[Question] What did Jesus tell Jews who had witnessed one of his miracles?
