6. Then he said to them; Where is your faith? But struck with fear, they marveled, saying to one another; Who really is this, for he orders even the winds and the water, and they obey him? (Luke 8:25)

[Question] How did Jesus' disciples feel, when he calmed sea and a violent thunderstorm?
