John 5:21~ For just as the Father raises the dead up and makes them alive, so the Son also makes those alive whom he wants to.

1. Then he told them, that just as the father had power to raise up even the dead, that the father had given him the power to do likewise. He could use this power toward anyone whom he wanted to. Up to this point in his ministry Jesus had not used this power, but he would in the near future.

4. With that he approached and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still, and he said; Young man, I say to you; Get up! (Luke 7:14)

[Question] What did Jesus later do, to demonstrate that he had this power, to give life to others?

5. But he took her by the hand and called, saying; Girl, get up! (Luke 8:54)

[Question] What did Jesus tell the daughter of Jarius, who had died at twelve years of age?

6. Jesus said to her; I am the resurrection and the life. He that exercises faith in me, even though he dies, will come to life. (John 11:25)
