

John 5:22~ For the Father judges no one at all, but he has committed all the judging to the Son.

- 1· Then Jesus showed, that Yehowah God was going to judge no one, but that he had committed all the judging to the Son.

[Question] Who then, did Jesus show, that all judging had been committed to?

- 2· And it came about on the next day, that Moses sat down as usual to serve as judge for the people, and the people kept standing before Moses, from the morning till the evening. (**Exodus 18:13**)

[Question] How did Moses prefigure Jesus, in this work of judging?

- 3· All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the **Son**, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the **Son**, and anyone to whom the **Son** is willing to reveal him. (**Matthew 11:27**)

[Question] Who knows the Father most intimately, and who also knows the Son best?

- 4· Also, he ordered us to preach to the people, and to give a thorough witness that this is the One decreed by God, to be judge of the living and the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 10:42**)

[Question] What commission do all anointed Christians have from God and Christ?

[Question] What is Christ before all mankind?

- 5· Because he **has** set a day in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness, by a man whom he **has** appointed, and he **has** furnished a guarantee to all men, in that he **has** resurrected him from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 17:31**)

[Question] How had Yehowah God set forth Jesus Christ to judge mankind, and what guarantee has Yehowah God given, that this will happen, regardless of how men feel about it?

- 6· For we must all be made manifest before the judgment seat of the Christ, that each one may get his award for the things done through the body, according to the things he

has practiced, whether it is good or vile. (2 Corinthians 5:10)

[Question] Where must all people become made manifest, and then what will be the basis of that judgment?

- 7· I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus, who is destined to judge the living and the dead, and by his manifestation and his kingdom. (2 Timothy 4:1)

[Question] Who is destined to judge the living and the dead among mankind?

- 8· Who **has** ascended to heaven, that he may descend? Who **has** gathered the wind in the hollow of both hands? Who **has** wrapped up the waters in a mantle? Who **has** made all the ends of the earth to rise? What is his name, and what the name of his son, in case you know? (Proverbs 30:4)

[Question] How do the Proverbs bear witness about the Christ?

- 9· And he **has** given him authority to do **judging**, because **Son** of man he is. (John 5:27)

[Question] Why had Yehowah God given Jesus authority to do judging?

- 10· This will be in the day when God through Christ Jesus, **judges** the secret things of mankind, according to the Good News I declare. (Romans 2:16)

[Question] Through whom, will Yehowah God judge the secret things of mankind, and what will be the basis of that judgment?

- 11· From this time on, there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give me as a reward in that day, yet not only to me, but also to all those who have loved his manifestation. (2 Timothy 4:8)

[Question] Who did the apostle Paul look to, to judge him after a life of faithful works in support of his Kingdom?
