

**John 5:24~** Most truly I say to you, he that hears my word and believes him that sent me, has everlasting life, and he does not come into judgment, but has passed over from death to life.

1· So he bore witness to them, that everyone who hears his word, and believes him that sent him forth, that one has everlasting life, because of putting faith in the Son Of Man. This one then would not come into judgment at all, but had passed over from death, which is the prospect that sins holds out for all mankind, and pass over to everlasting life.

[Question] Who among mankind has everlasting life?

[Question] Why would such ones not enter into judgment at all, and what have they passed over from, and to?

2· For God loved the world so much that he gave his only-begotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have **everlasting life**. (John 3:16)

[Question] How did Yehowah God express his great love for mankind?

[Question] What does Yehowah God want all men to attain to?

3· For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son and exercises faith in him, should have **everlasting life**, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)

[Question] What is the will of Yehowah God for mankind?

[Question] How only will everlasting life come to the human family?

4· Most truly I say to you, if anyone observes my word, he will never see **death** at all. (John 8:51)

[Question] What did Jesus state about anyone observing his word, and putting it into practice?

5· We know we have **passed** over from **death** to **life**, because we love the brothers. He who does not love, remains in **death**. (1 John 3:14)

[Question] What proves, that anointed Christians have passed over from death to life?

**[Question]** What hope for the future do people who have not learned to love, remain in?

- 6· He that exercises faith in him, is not to be judged. He that does not exercise faith, **has** been judged already, because he **has** not exercised faith, in the name of the only-begotten Son of God. (**John 3:18**)

**[Question]** Who will not be judged?

**[Question]** Why have people failing to exercise faith in Jesus, already been judged?

- 7· And I give them **everlasting life**, and they will by no means ever be destroyed, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. (**John 10:28**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus Christ promise to give to his faithful disciples?

- 8· Jesus said to her; I am the resurrection and the **life**. He that exercises faith in me, even though he dies, will **come to life**. (**John 11:25**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus say he himself was, and what would anyone exercising faith in him gain for himself?

- 9· But these have been written down, that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that, because of believing, you may have **life** by means of his name. (**John 20:31**)

**[Question]** Why were the four gospel accounts written down for us today, and what hope do they hold forth for all mankind?

- 10· For the Law of that spirit, which gives **life** in union with Christ Jesus, **has** set you free from the Law of sin and of **death**. (**Romans 8:2**)

**[Question]** What had set anointed Christians free from the law of sin and death, the Law Covenant?

- 11· But now it **has** been made clearly evident through the manifestation of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who **has** abolished **death**, but **has** shed light, upon **life**, and incorruption, through the Good News. (**2 Timothy 1:10**)

**[Question]** What had Jesus Christ abolished through faith in him, and what form of future life, has he shed light upon?
