1· Jesus then showed, that he had been given the authority to do judging, because he was also a human being, and therefore one understanding what it was like to be a human being. He could then be compassionate and kindly, showing fellow feeling, for he had the same kind of existence as other men.

4· I kept on beholding in the visions of the night, and see, there! With the clouds of the heavens someone like a son of **man happened to be coming. To the Ancient of Days he gained access, and they brought him up close even before that One. (Daniel 7:13)**

[Question] Where was the Son Of Man brought, and who did he gain access to?
