

John 5:28~ Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice.

- 1· Then he told them not to marvel because the hour was fast approaching, when he would call out with his voice, and cause all the dead within the memorial tombs to come to life again.

[Question] What hour did Jesus tell his disciples was coming, and not to marvel over, and what then would happen?

- 2· O that in Sheol you would conceal me, that you would keep me secret until your anger turns back, that you would set a time limit for me and remember me! (**Job 14:13**)

[Question] What did Job want for Yehowah God to do for him, in time?

- 3· He **will** actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **will** certainly wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people, he **will** take away from all the earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (**Isaiah 25:8**)

[Question] What has Yehowah God promised to do for mankind, and what will he wipe from their faces, and take away forever?

- 4· Your dead ones **will** live. A corpse of mine, they **will** rise up. Awake and cry out joyfully, you residents in the dust! For your dew is as the dew of mallows, and the earth itself **will** let even those impotent in death, drop in birth. (**Isaiah 26:19**)

[Question] How did Isaiah prophesy about the resurrection of human dead?

- 5· And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. But another scroll was opened, it is the scroll of life. And the dead were judged out of those things written in the scrolls, according to their deeds. (**Revelation 20:12**)

[Question] What vision of judgment day is shown in Revelation, and how are people then judged?

- 6· Finally Yehowah listened to Elijah's **voice**, so that the soul of the child came back within him, and he came to life. (**1**

Kings 17:22)

[Question] What did Elijah do for a dead child, proving the resurrection truthful?

- 7· You **will** call, and I myself shall answer you. For the work of your hands you **will** have a yearning. (**Job 14:15**)

[Question] What confidence did Job have in Yehowah God?

- 8· And there **will** be many of those asleep in the ground of dust who **will** wake up, these to indefinitely lasting life and those to reproaches and to indefinitely lasting abhorrence. (**Daniel 12:2**)

[Question] What did Daniel prophesy would happen in a future day, and how would judgment then proceed?

- 9· However, in order for you to know, that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins, then he said to the paralytic; Get up, pick up your bed, and go to your home. (**Matthew 9:6**)

[Question] What authority did Jesus have on the earth?

- 10· But the women, who had come with him out of Galilee, followed along and took a look at the **memorial** tomb, and how his body was laid. (**Luke 23:55**)

[Question] How did the women feel when Jesus died?

- 11· This is the **will** of him that sent me, that I should lose nothing out of all that he has given me, but that I should resurrect it at the last day. (**John 6:39**)

[Question] When will Jesus show his power to resurrect people, and will any putting faith in him be lost then?

- 12· Consequently when Jesus arrived, he found he had already been four days in the **memorial** tomb. (**John 11:17**)

[Question] What did Jesus do for his friend Lazarus, who had been dead for four days?

- 13· Hence Jesus, after groaning again within himself, came to the **memorial** tomb. It was, in fact, a cave, and a stone was lying against it. (**John 11:38**)

[Question] How did Jesus feel within himself, when resurrecting Lazarus his friend?

- 14· And I have hope toward God, which hope these men themselves also entertain, that there is going to be a resurrection, of both the righteous and the unrighteous. (Acts of Apostles 24:15)**

[Question] What hope did Paul entertain about his own future, and that of other Christians?

- 15· I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus, who is destined to judge the living and the dead, and by his manifestation and his kingdom. (2 Timothy 4:1)**

[Question] Who is destined to judge the living and the dead on judgment day?

- 16· The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection. (Revelation 20:5)**

[Question] When only, do the remaining ones of mankind, come to life?

[Question] When though, do those who are part of the first resurrection get resurrected?
