

**John 5:29~** **And come out, those who did good things to a resurrection of life, those who practiced vile things to a resurrection of judgment.**<sup>1</sup>

**Footnote: Resurrection of judgment** Greek, *a-na'sta-sin kri'se-os*; Latin, *re-sur-rec-ti-o'nem iu-di'ci-i*

**1· Then at that time those who had practiced good things, would come forth to a resurrection of life, and those who had practiced vile things, to a resurrection of judgment. Therefore our present lives serve as a basis for judgment from God and his Christ, and failure to accept Jesus Christ as savior of the world, simply leaves us under condemnation.**

**[Question]** What did Jesus state, that those ones would then come forth to?

**[Question]** What then, do our present lives serve as, and what will failure to accept the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, leave men under?

**2· And there will be many of those asleep in the ground of dust who will wake up, these to indefinitely lasting life, and those to reproaches, and to indefinitely lasting abhorrence. (Daniel 12:2)**

**[Question]** What did Daniel then tell them, that would happen during the resurrection?

**3· And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. But another scroll was opened, it is the scroll of life. And the dead were judged out of those things written in the scrolls according to their deeds. (Revelation 20:12)**

**[Question]** What vision within Revelation shows the time of judgment?

**[Question]** According to what, are people then judged?

**4· Yehowah knows how to deliver people of godly devotion out of trial, but to reserve unrighteous people for the day of judgment to be cut off. (2 Peter 2:9)**

**[Question]** What has Yehowah God shown many times, that he can accomplish?

**5· Furthermore, whoever was not found written in the book of life was hurled into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:15)**

**[Question]** Where are all those thrown, whose names are not inscribed in the book of life, and what does this mean?

- 6· **I myself have said in my heart; The true God will judge both the righteous one and the wicked one, for there is a time for every affair and concerning every work there. (Ecclesiastes 3:17)**

**[Question]** What time is fast approaching for all mankind, and who then will be judged?

- 7· **Your dead ones will live. A corpse of mine, they will rise up. Awake and cry **out** joyfully, you residents in the dust! For your dew is as the dew of mallows, and the earth itself will let even those impotent in death drop in birth. (Isaiah 26:19)**

**[Question]** How did Isaiah describe the resurrection?

- 8· **Consequently I say to you, it will be more endurable for Tyre and Sidon on Judgment Day than for you. (Matthew 11:22)**

**[Question]** Who did Jesus show that would fare better on judgment day, and why?

- 9· **And you will be happy, because they have nothing with which to repay you. For you will be repaid in the **resurrection** of the righteous ones. (Luke 14:14)**

**[Question]** When also will Yehowah God repay those, who did good things to people in need in this life?

- 10· **But those who have been counted worthy of gaining that system of **things**, and the **resurrection** from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage. (Luke 20:35)**

**[Question]** Do men and women marry, that come forth through the resurrection?

- 11· **In fact, neither can they die anymore, for they are like the angels, and they are God's children by being children of the **resurrection**. (Luke 20:36)**

**[Question]** What also is no longer possible for resurrected ones then, for what existence then do they have, and whose children are they?

- 12· **And he said to him; Truly I tell you today, you will be with me in Paradise. (Luke 23:43)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus promise an evildoer, who put faith in him?

- 13· **Martha said to him; I know he will rise in the resurrection on the last day. (John 11:24)**

**[Question]** What faith, did Martha have in this future resurrection?

- 14· **But certain ones of both the Epicurean and the Stoic philosophers took to conversing with him controversially, and some would say; What is it this chatterer would like to tell? Others; He seems to be a publisher of foreign deities. This was, because he was declaring the Good News of Jesus and the resurrection. (Acts of Apostles 17:18)**

**[Question]** How did many of the Greek philosophers feel about the resurrection, which Paul preached?

- 15· **And he will render to each one according to his works. (Romans 2:6)**

**[Question]** How will Yehowah God render back to each person?

- 16· **The teaching on baptisms and the laying on of the hands, the resurrection of the dead and everlasting judgment. (Hebrews 6:2)**

**[Question]** What are some basic teachings of the Bible?

- 17· **And the sea gave up those dead in it, and death and Hades gave up those dead in them, and they were judged individually, according to their deeds. (Revelation 20:13)**

**[Question]** How will the dead be judged when they are resurrected, based upon what?
