John 5:31~ If I alone bear witness about myself, my witness is not true.

1. Then Jesus remarked, that if he was the only one bearing witness about himself, then his witness would not be as believable. For under the Law Covenant, two witnesses were required to attest to every matter of serious concern.

[Question] What did Jesus state would be the case, if his witness stood alone?

[Question] What was required to establish any serious matter, under the Law Covenant?

2. No single witness should rise up against a man respecting any error or any sin, in the case of any sin that he may commit. At the mouth of two witnesses or at the mouth of three witnesses the matter should stand good.

(Deuteronomy 19:15)

[Question] What did the Law Covenant require, in the way of witnesses, to convict a man of serious sin?

3. In answer Jesus said to them; Even if I do bear witness about myself, my witness is true, because I know where I came from and where I am going. But you do not know where I came from and where I am going. (John 8:14)

[Question] Why could even the solitary witness of Jesus Christ be believed?
