

John 5:33~ You have dispatched men to John, and he has borne witness to the truth.

- 1· Also Jesus spoke to them about a third witness, that of John the Baptist, whom they had sent messengers of theirs to, and he also bore witness to the truth about Jesus Christ, for he had seen the Holy Spirit come down upon him, and heard the voice of God, declaring Jesus to be his beloved Son.

[Question] Who also proved to be a third witness, that Jesus was the Christ, for what had John the Baptist personally seen at Jesus' baptism?

- 2· John bore witness about him, yes, he actually cried out, this was the one who said it, saying; The one coming behind me has advanced in front of me, because he existed before me. (**John 1:15**)

[Question] How did John the Baptist bear witness about Jesus?

- 3· John also bore witness, saying; I viewed the spirit coming down as a dove out of heaven, and it remained upon him. (**John 1:32**)

[Question] What did John the Baptist bear witness, that he had been told to look for by the Holy Spirit, and that he had seen at Jesus' baptism?

- 4· And I have seen it, and I have borne witness that this one is the Son of God. (**John 1:34**)

[Question] What then, did John the Baptist bear witness to about Jesus Christ?

- 5· And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (**Revelation 14:5**)

[Question] How are the holy anointed sons of God described in the Revelation account?
