John 5:35~ That man was a burning and shining lamp, and you for a short time were willing to rejoice greatly in his light.

1. Then Jesus referenced the work of John the Baptist and said, that, that man was a shining lamp, and many in Israel were for a short time willing to rejoice in his light.

[Question] What did Jesus then state, about the works of John the Baptist, for what was he like within Israel for a short time?

2. Then Jerusalem and all Judea and all the country around the Jordan, made their way out to him. (Matthew 3:5)

[Question] Who made their way out to John the Baptist, to see him and hear him preach?

3. As for the one sown upon the rocky places, this is the one hearing the word, and at once, accepting it with joy. (Matthew 13:20)

[Question] Who are like the ones sown among the rocky places?

4. For Herod stood in fear of John, knowing him to be a righteous and holy man, and he was keeping him safe. And after hearing him, he was at a great loss what to do, yet he continued to hear him gladly. (Mark 6:20)

[Question] How did Herod view John the Baptist, and so why did he imprison him?

5. Consequently we have the prophetic word made more sure. You are doing well in paying attention to it, as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until day dawns, and a daystar rises in your hearts. (2 Peter 1:19)

[Question] How has the coming of Jesus Christ, made the prophetic word of Yehowah God more sure?

[Question] What is the shining light of the Christ like, pointing the way forward to a wholesome future for mankind?
