

John 5:36~ But I have the witness greater than that of John, for the very works that my Father assigned me to accomplish, the works themselves that I am doing, bear witness about me, that the Father dispatched me.

1· Jesus then showed, that his witness was far greater than that of John the Baptist's witness about him, for it was not a witness of words but of fine works and powerful ones, that God himself participated in to show his approval of Jesus Christ. This could not be denied, for it was by the power of God.

[Question] Why could Jesus state, that the witness he gave was far stronger, than the witness of John the Baptist?

[Question] Whose divine power, was part of every one of Jesus' miracles?

2· The blind are seeing again, and the lame are walking about, the lepers are being cleansed, and the deaf are hearing, and the dead are being raised up, and the poor are having the Good News declared to them. (Matthew 11:5)

[Question] What did Jesus tell two of John the Baptist's disciples, that he was accomplishing daily?

3· This one came to him in the night and said to him; Rabbi, we know that you as a teacher have come from God. For no one can perform these signs that you perform, unless God is with him. (John 3:2)

[Question] What did Nicodemus state to Jesus, that was positive proof to him, that Jesus was from Yehowah God?

4· Still, many of the crowd put faith in him, and they commenced saying; When the Christ arrives, he will not perform more signs than this man has performed, will he? (John 7:31)

[Question] What did the crowds put faith in, and why did they reason Jesus was the Messiah?

5· Jesus answered them; I told you, and yet you do not believe. The works that I am doing in the name of my Father, these bear witness about me. (John 10:25)

[Question] What did himself bear witness to, that the people should believe because of?

- 6· **Then Moses said; By this, you will know that Yehowah has sent me to do all these deeds, that it is not of my own heart. (Numbers 16:28)**

[Question] What did Moses state, that he was sent forth to accomplish?

- 7· **He was not that light, but he was meant to bear witness about that light. (John 1:8)**

[Question] What was the purpose, of the sending forth of John the Baptist?

- 8· **Jesus said to them; My food is for me to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. (John 4:34)**

[Question] What did Jesus see as his daily food, that kept him going throughout his ministry?

- 9· **If this man were not from God, he could do nothing at all. (John 9:33)**

[Question] What powerful works could Jesus not accomplish, if he were not from God?

- 10· **If I am not doing the works of my Father, do not believe me. (John 10:37)**

[Question] What did Jesus tell them, was reason enough to believe in him then, and still is today?

- 11· **Believe me that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me, otherwise, believe on account of the works themselves. (John 14:11)**

[Question] What did Jesus want others to believe about him, and what served as proof positive, that he was from Yehowah God?

- 12· **Jesus, therefore, said to them again; May you have peace. Just as the Father has sent me forth, I also am sending you. (John 20:21)**

[Question] How did Jesus pass the authority Yehowah God gave to him, down through his apostles and disciples?

- 13· Men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus the Nazarene, a man publicly shown by God to you, through powerful works and portents and signs, that God did through him in your midst, just as you yourselves know. (Acts of Apostles 2:22)**

[Question] How was Jesus revealed to the men of Israel, and what then served as positive proof, that Yehowah God had sent him forth?

- 14· You yourselves are our letter, inscribed on our hearts and known and being read by all mankind. (2 Corinthians 3:2)**

[Question] What did anointed Christians in Corinth serve as, before all the world of mankind, in Paul's behalf?
