

John 5:37~ **Also, the Father who sent me has himself borne witness about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his figure.**

1· Jesus then told his opposers, that the Father had also borne witness about him, for he had spoken from heaven declaring Jesus to be his beloved Son. Yet these men to whom Jesus was speaking, had neither heard God's voice at any time, nor had any of them ever seen God, yet they acted like they knew more than his own Son.

[Question] What did Jesus tell his opposers about who had borne witness respecting him?

[Question] What though, had those men not heard for themselves?

2· While he was yet speaking, look! A bright cloud overshadowed them, and, look! A voice out of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I have approved. Listen to him. (Matthew 17:5)

[Question] How did Yehowah God bear witness concerning Jesus, to three of his closest disciples?

3· And a voice came out of the heavens; You are my Son, the beloved. I have approved you. (Mark 1:11)

[Question] What voice from the heavens at his baptism bore witness to men respecting Jesus?

4· I am one that bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me, bears witness about me. (John 8:18)

[Question] Who could Jesus say, had also borne witness concerning him?

5· In answer Jesus said; This voice has occurred, not for my sake, but for your sakes. (John 12:30)

[Question] Why did Jesus ask for Yehowah God to glorify his own name, when before a crowd of people as he entered Jerusalem?

6· If we receive the witness men give, the witness God gives is greater, because this is the witness God gives, the fact that he has borne witness concerning his Son. (1 John 5:9)

[Question] What is the witness that Yehowah God has given concerning Jesus Christ, and how in several ways was this expressed?

- 7· **And Yehowah began to speak to you out of the middle of the fire. The sound of words was what you were hearing, but no form were you seeing, nothing but a **voice**. (Deuteronomy 4:12)**

[Question] How did Yehowah God speak to Israel there in the mountain, and what did they see and hear?

- 8· **No man **has seen** God at any time. The only-begotten god who is in the bosom position with the Father is the one that **has explained** him. (John 1:18)**

[Question] Has any man ever seen Yehowah God while a man?

[Question] Who alone lived in heaven before coming to the earth, and has explained Yehowah God to mankind?

- 9· **Not that any man **has seen** the Father, except he who is from God. This one **has seen** the Father. (John 6:46)**

[Question] What man alone has seen God, though not while a man?

- 10· **Now to the King of eternity, incorruptible, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. (1 Timothy 1:17)**

[Question] What is this glorious God worthy of forever?

- 11· **At no time **has** anyone beheld God. If we continue loving one another, God remains in us, and his love is made perfect in us. (1 John 4:12)**

[Question] Has any man ever beheld Yehowah God while a man?

[Question] What remains within men, if they continue loving one another, and how is this perfected over time?

- 12· **This means everlasting life, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you **sent** forth, Jesus Christ. (John 17:3)**

[Question] What does taking in knowledge of Yehowah God and Jesus Christ, mean for mankind?

- 13· **The person putting his faith in the Son of God **has** the**

witness given in his own case. The person not having faith in God **has** made him a liar, because he **has** not put his faith in the **witness** given, which God as **witness has** given concerning his Son. (1 John 5:10)

[Question] How does Yehowah God give witness to all those who put faith in his son, Jesus Christ?

[Question] What does the man refusing to put faith in Jesus, in effect call Yehowah God?
