John 5:38~ And you do not have his word remaining in you, because the very one whom he dispatched, you do not believe.

1. He then told these religious leaders who were charged with presenting the word of God to his people, that they no longer had his word remaining in them, because they had refused to believe the one whom God himself had dispatched to them.

[Question] What were these religious leaders charged with, before the people of Israel?

[Question] Why though, could they not effectively do this work?

2. And so Jesus went on to say to the Jews that had believed him; If you remain in my word, you are really my disciples. (John 8:31)

[Question] Who did Jesus state, would really become his disciples?

3. In the first place, concerning sin, because they are not exercising faith in me. (John 16:9)

[Question] What will those not exercising faith in Jesus, not be excused from?
