1. Yet Jesus confessed to them, that they did not want to come to the one Yehowah God had send to deliver them from their sins, so that they might get life.

[Question] Who though, did the Jews and their religious leaders, not want to come to, to what end?

2. He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains, and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (Isaiah 53:3)

[Question] What kind of a man was the coming Messiah prophesied to be, and did Jesus Christ fulfill this?

3. He came to his own home, but his own people did not take him in. (John 1:11)

[Question] Where did Jesus preach and teach, yet how did the people of his home territory feel about him?
