I have come in the name of my Father, but you do not receive me, if someone else arrived in his own name, you would receive that one.

1. Jesus then told them, that he had come forth in his Father's name, but they did not receive him, as they should have with respect. He then told them, that if someone else arrived in his own name, that they would readily accept such a one.

[Question] Whose name did Jesus come forth in, and yet how was he received?

[Question] What did Jesus by comparison show, that they would receive if one came in his own name?

2. Then God said once more to Moses; This is what you are to say to the sons of Israel, Yehowah the God of your forefathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is my name to time indefinite, and this is the memorial of me to generation after generation. (Exodus 3:15)

[Question] In whose name did Moses approach the older men of Israel?

3. As for the crowds, those going ahead of him and those following kept crying out; Save, we pray, the Son of David! Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name! Save him, we pray, in the heights above! (Matthew 21:9)

[Question] What was called out ahead of Jesus, when he made his triumphal entry into Jerusalem?
