John 5:46~ In fact, if you believed Moses, you would believe me, for that one wrote about me.

1. In fact, Jesus told them, that if they believed in Moses, then they should also believe in him, for Moses himself wrote about him.

[Question] Why did Jesus tell these religious leaders thereafter, if they believed in Moses, they should also believe in him?

2. And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)

[Question] What did Yehowah God state would exist between the seed of Satan the Devil, and the seed of the woman, throughout history?

3. The scepter will not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him, the obedience of the peoples will belong. (Genesis 49:10)

[Question] Where did Yehowah God state that the commander's staff would reside within Israel's twelve tribes, and until when?

4. A prophet from your own midst, from your brothers, like me, is what Yehowah your God will raise up for you, to him you people should listen. (Deuteronomy 18:15)

[Question] What did Yehowah God show through Moses, that he would raise up for Israel, and from where?

5. He now said to them; These are my words which I spoke to you while I was yet with you, that all the things written in the Law of Moses, and in the Prophets and Psalms about me, must be fulfilled. (Luke 24:44)

[Question] What things did Jesus show his disciples, must be fulfilled in him?

6' Philip found Nathanael and said to him; We have found the one of whom Moses, in the Law, and the Prophets wrote, Jesus, the son of Joseph, from Nazareth. (John 1:45)

[Question] How did Phillip identify Jesus as the coming Messiah, and who did he immediately tell about this?

7. However, because I have obtained the help that is from God, I continue to this day bearing witness to both small and great, but saying nothing except things the Prophets, as well as Moses, stated were going to take place. (Acts of Apostles 26:22)

[Question] How did Paul bear witness that all the things he preached about Jesus came forth from the Hebrew Scriptures?

8. A prophet I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you, and I shall indeed put my words in his mouth, and he will certainly speak to them all that I shall command him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)

[Question] What prophets did Yehowah God prophesy would come forth to his people, and who would he be like?

9. But he said to him, if they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone rises from the dead. (Luke 16:31)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them it was pointless to send to them, if they rejected Moses and the prophets?

10. They now arranged for a day with him, and they came in greater numbers to him in his lodging place. And he explained the matter to them by bearing thorough witness concerning the kingdom of God, and by using persuasion with them concerning Jesus, from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening. (Acts of Apostles 28:23)
