^{John 5:9~} With that the man immediately became sound in health, and he picked up his cot and began to walk. Now on that day it was a Sabbath.

1. At his word, the man who had been sick for thirty-eight years became sound in health, and he did pick up his cot and began to walk. Now the day that Jesus performed this healing was also a Sabbath.

[Question] What then, happened to this man who had been sick thirty-eight years?

[Question] What day was it, when Jesus performed this cure?

2. Incidentally it was Sabbath on the day that Jesus made the clay and opened his eyes. (John 9:14)

[Question] What day was it, when Jesus performed many of his signs and miracles, and why did he pick this time?

3. If a man receives circumcision on a Sabbath, in order, that the Law of Moses may not be broken, are you violently angry at me, because I made a man completely sound in health on a Sabbath? (John 7:23)

[Question] What was a man to receive even if the eighth day fell upon the Sabbath?

[Question] Why then was a healing of sickness viable work to do on a Sabbath?
