

John 6:1~ After these things Jesus departed across the sea of Galilee, or Tiberias.

- 1· So after the festival had ended, Jesus left Jerusalem, and departed across the Sea of Galilee or Tiberias.

[Question] Where now, did Jesus go to, after the festival ended?

- 2· At hearing this **Jesus** withdrew from there by boat into a lonely place for isolation, but the crowds, getting to hear of it, followed him on foot from the cities. (**Matthew 14:13**)

[Question] Who though, followed Jesus wherever he went, even into lonely places?

- 3· And when the apostles returned they recounted to him what **things** they had done. With that he took them along and withdrew to privacy into a city called Bethsaida. (**Luke 9:10**)

[Question] Where did Jesus withdraw to, when his apostles returned from their preaching tour of Israel?

- 4· And the boundary must go down from Shepham to Riblah on the east of Ain, and the border must go down and strike upon the eastern slope of the **sea** of Chinnereth. (**Numbers 34:11**)

[Question] What served as a boundary for the land of Israel on the east?

- 5· And the Arabah as far as the **sea** of Chinnereth toward the east and as far as the **sea** of the Arabah, the Salt Sea, to the east in the direction of Beth-jeshimoth, and toward the south under the slopes of Pisgah. (**Joshua 12:3**)

[Question] What was the Sea of Galilee also called, and what did it serve as within Israel?

- 6· And in the low plain Beth-haram and Beth-nimrah and Succoth and Zaphon, the rest of the royal realm of Sihon the king of Heshbon, the Jordan being the border as far as the extremity of the **sea** of Chinnereth on the side of Jordan toward the east. (**Joshua 13:27**)
