

John 6:11~ So Jesus took the loaves, and after giving thanks, he distributed them to those reclining, likewise also as much of the small fishes as they wanted.

- 1· So Jesus started off with the five loaves and offered a prayer of thanks to God, and started to break apart the loaves and the fishes. They placed them within baskets and handed them out to the crowds and all ate to satisfaction.

[Question] How did Jesus start this meal, and what did he offer to the people first to eat, and did the people all get enough to eat?

- 2· At that he put it before them, and they began to eat, and they had leftovers according to the word of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 4:44**)

[Question] What had Yehowah God earlier miraculously provided for his people, and was there enough then?

- 3· Taking now the five loaves and the two fishes he looked up to heaven and said a blessing, and broke the loaves up and began giving them to the disciples, that these might place them before the people, and he divided up the two fishes for all. (**Mark 6:41**)

[Question] How did Jesus start this meal?

[Question] What then, did he do with the loaves and the fishes, that he broke for the crowds?

- 4· Then taking the five loaves and the two fishes, he looked up to heaven, blessed them and broke them up, and began to give them to the disciples to set before the crowd. (**Luke 9:16**)

[Question] Who did Jesus himself distribute the loaves and fishes to?

- 5· For the Father has affection for the Son, and shows him all the things he himself does, and he will show him works greater than these, in order, that you may marvel. (**John 5:20**)

[Question] What works had Jesus earlier told them, that Yehowah God would perform through him, and to what end?

- 6· Jesus answered them and said; Most truly I say to you,

you are looking for me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate from the loaves and were satisfied. (John 6:26)

[Question] Why did Jesus tell men, that they were looking for him, and so what motivated these men?

7· After he said this, he also took a loaf, gave thanks to God before them all, and broke it, and started eating. (Acts of Apostles 27:35)

[Question] How did Paul likewise start a meal before many others?
