But when they had their fill he said to his disciples; Gather together the fragments that remain over, so that nothing is wasted.

1. Then when all had eaten to satisfaction Jesus instructed his disciples to gather together all that remained over, so that nothing would be wasted.

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, when all of the crowd had eaten to satisfaction?

2. So they all ate and were satisfied. (Mark 6:42)

[Question] How many then ate this meal, and was there enough for all to eat?

3. Then she took it up and went into the city, and her motherin-law got to see what she had gleaned. After that she took out what food she had left over, when she had satisfied herself, and gave it to her. (Ruth 2:18)

[Question] How did Ruth fare, when gleaning in the fields of Boaz?

4. And it came about, that as soon as the vessels were full, she went on to say to her son; Do bring still another vessel near to me. But he said to her; There is no other vessel. At that the oil stopped. (2 Kings 4:6)

[Question] When only did the food run out for Elijah, and the woman he stayed with?

5. So all ate and were satisfied, and they took up the surplus of fragments, twelve baskets full. (Matthew 14:20)

[Question] How many provision baskets full of food were then taken up, as a surplus of fragments?
