

**John 6:13~**

**Therefore they gathered them together, and they filled twelve baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves, which were left over by those who had eaten.**

- 1· So his disciples took up all of the leftovers and they amounted to 12 provision baskets full, far more than they had to start with.**

**[Question]** What did the leftovers from this meal amount to, and was anything wasted?

**[Question]** How did the leftover food relate, to what they had started with?

- 2· So all ate and were satisfied, and they took up the surplus of **fragments, twelve baskets** full. (**Matthew 14:20**)**

**[Question]** How many men then ate and were satisfied, and how much was left over?

- 3· And they took up **fragments, twelve baskets** full, aside from the fishes. (**Mark 6:43**)**

**[Question]** How many baskets full of provisions, did they take up as leftovers from this meal?

- 4· So they all ate and were satisfied, and the surplus that they had was taken up, **twelve baskets** of **fragments**. (**Luke 9:17**)**

**[Question]** Did the people then get enough to eat, and what was left over?

- 5· At that he put it before them, and they began to eat, and they had leftovers, according to the word of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 4:44**)**

**[Question]** What had earlier happened within ancient Israel, in a similar manner?

- 6· Furthermore, those who ate of the **loaves** were **five** thousand men. (**Mark 6:44**)**

**[Question]** How many men were there, to share in this meal?

- 7· When I broke the **five loaves** for the **five** thousand men, how many **baskets** full of **fragments** you took up? They**

said to him; Twelve. (**Mark 8:19**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus later remind them of, when they were worried about not having any loaves to eat?
