John 6:14~ Hence when the men saw the signs he performed, they began to say; This is for a certainty, the prophet that was to come into the world.

1. So when people began to see the glorious signs he was performing, they began to say about him, that he must be the prophet that the scriptures had foretold was coming into the world.

[Question] What did the people or Israel then feel, when they saw such miracles, and who did they think Jesus to be?

2. A prophet from your own midst, from your brothers, like me, is what Yehowah your God will raise up for you, to him you people should listen. (Deuteronomy 18:15)

[Question] What kind of a prophet did Yehowah God, through Moses, promise to raise up for his people?

[Question] Had Moses feed the people meat miraculously while in the wilderness, and what about the daily manna and water there also?

3. A prophet I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you. I shall indeed put my words in his mouth, and he will certainly speak to them all that I shall command him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)

[Question] Whose words would this prophet like Moses, speak to the people?

4 For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

[Question] What rule would come to be upon the shoulders of this son given to Israel?

[Question] What fine roles, would he then come to fulfill?

5. And he said to them; What things? They said to him; The things concerning Jesus the Nazarene, who became a prophet powerful in work and word before God and all the people. (Luke 24:19)

[Question] How did Jesus Christ manifest himself to Israel, through what?

6. In fact, Moses said; Yehowah God will raise up for you from among your brothers, a prophet like me. You must listen to him, according to all the things he speaks to you. (Acts of Apostles 3:22)

[Question] What kind of a prophet did Moses show would come forth, and where would he come forth from?

7. And, without delay, he compelled his disciples to board the boat and go on ahead to the opposite shore toward Bethsaida, while he himself dismissed the crowd. (Mark 6:45)

[Question] Where now did Jesus compel his disciples to go, and how would they get there?

[Question] What then, did Jesus himself do, after feeding this large crowd?

8. Now fear seized them all, and they began to glorify God, saying; A great prophet has been raised up among us, and, God has turned his attention to his people. (Luke 7:16)

[Question] How did the people who were thus fed by Jesus, feel, upon seeing this powerful work?

9. And they asked him; What, then? Are you Elijah? And he said; I am not. Are you The Prophet? And he answered; No! (John 1:21)

[Question] What did the people ask of John the Baptist, and how did he reply?

10" And there was a lot of subdued talk about him among the crowds. Some would say; He is a good man. Others would say; He is not, but he misleads the crowd. (John 7:12)

[Question] What kind of talk then spread about Jesus and his ministry?

11. Therefore some of the crowd that heard these words began saying; This is for a certainty, The Prophet. (John 7:40)

[Question] What did the crowds then come to feel, and say, about Jesus?

12. She said to him; Yes, Lord. I have believed that you are the Christ the Son of God, the One coming into the world.

(John 11:27)

[Question] What did Martha state, that she felt Jesus was?
