

John 6:15~ Therefore, Jesus, knowing they were about to come and seize him to make him king, withdrew again into the mountain all alone.

- 1· So then, Jesus, knowing the thoughts of the people, that they were about to come and try to make him king of Israel, withdrew again into the mountain all alone.

[Question] Where then, did Jesus go to, for what did he see within the mindset of the crowds respecting himself?

- 2· Eventually, having sent the crowds away, he went up into the **mountain** by himself to pray. Though it became late, he was there **alone**. (**Matthew 14:23**)

[Question] Where then, did Jesus go, and what did he do there while alone, and until when?

- 3· And, without delay, he compelled his disciples to board the boat and go on ahead to the opposite shore toward Bethsaida, while he himself dismissed the crowd. (**Mark 6:45**)

[Question] Where did Jesus compel his disciples to go directly after feeding the crowd, and where did they then head for?

- 4· They are no part of the world, just as I am no part of the world. (**John 17:16**)

[Question] Were Jesus, or any of his disciples, part of this present system of things, this world?

- 5· Jesus answered; My kingdom is no part of this world. If my kingdom were part of this world, my attendants would have fought, that I should not be delivered up to the Jews. But, as it is, my kingdom is not from this source. (**John 18:36**)

[Question] What did Jesus show, would have happened at his arrest, if his Kingdom were part of this world?

[Question] What though, is the source of Christ's Kingdom?

- 6· The form of worship that is clean and undefiled from the standpoint of our God and Father is this. To look after orphans and widows in their tribulation, and to keep

oneself without spot from the world. (**James 1:27**)

[Question] What kind of worship, is clean and undefiled before Yehowah God?

- 7· **Adulteresses, do you not know, that the friendship with the world, is enmity with God? Whoever, therefore, wants to be a friend of the world, is constituting himself an enemy of God. (James 4:4)**

[Question] What does friendship with the world alienated from God, lead to in our relationship with Yehowah God?

[Question] What is anyone making himself a friend of this world, making himself before Yehowah God?

- 8· **For each one will lay hold of his brother in the house of his father, saying; You have a mantle. A dictator you ought to become to us, and this overthrown mass should be under your hand. (Isaiah 3:6)**

[Question] How did men in Isaiah's day take rulership to themselves, though unqualified?

- 9· **Then, without delay, he compelled his disciples to board the boat, and go ahead of him to the other side, while he sent the crowds away. (Matthew 14:22)**

[Question] What did Jesus then do, after feeding this large crowd?

- 10· **But Jesus himself was not entrusting himself to them, because of his knowing them all (John 2:24)**

[Question] Why did Jesus not entrust himself to men?
