John 6:18~ Also, the sea began to be stirred up because a strong wind was blowing.

1. Also that night the sea became stirred up by the winds, and a strong wind was blowing toward them from the western shore of the lake.

[Question] What came up that night, and where was it blowing from?

2. Now, look! A great agitation arose in the sea, so that the boat was being covered by the waves. He, however, was sleeping. (Matthew 8:24)

[Question] What had happened earlier to their little boat, when crossing the Sea of Galilee, on another occasion?

3. By now the boat was many hundreds of yards away from land, being hard put to it by the waves, because the wind was against them. (Matthew 14:24)

[Question] Where then, was their boat, and were they making much headway against the wind?

4. And when he saw them being hard put to it in their rowing, for the wind was against them, about the fourth watch of the night he came toward them, walking on the sea, but he was inclined to pass them by. (Mark 6:48)

[Question] When did Jesus come to them, walking upon the sea, and what then was his inclination?
