- 1· Yet a great crowd kept following him, for they were beholding and marveling over the signs he was performing for the sickly ones among them.**

[Question] Who though, followed after Jesus, and why?

- 2· But people saw them going and many got to know it, and from all the cities they ran there together on foot and got ahead of them. (Mark 6:33)**

[Question] Where did the people come from, to hear and see Jesus, and to be healed by him?

- 3· But the crowds, getting to know it, followed him. And he received them kindly, and began to speak to them about the kingdom of God, and he healed those needing a cure. (Luke 9:11)**

[Question] How did Jesus always receive these large crowds, and what did he always do for them?

- 4· However, when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover, at its festival, many people put their faith in his name, viewing his signs that he was performing. (John 2:23)**

[Question] What did many people put faith in, while Jesus was in Jerusalem, and why?

- 5· But the word about him was spreading the more, and great crowds would come together to listen and to be cured of their sicknesses. (Luke 5:15)**

[Question] How widespread was Jesus fame in his own day, and who came to hear him?
