Jesus answered them and said; Most truly I say to you, you are looking for me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate from the loaves and were satisfied.

1. So Jesus avoided answering directly, and told the crowds, that they were looking for him, not because they saw signs, but because he had fed them. This indicated, that their interest in him was not spiritual, but earthly, based upon their material needs.

[Question] So now, what did Jesus reveal was the reason, why most of these people were looking for him?

[Question] What did this show that motivated them?

2. So Jesus took the loaves and, after giving thanks, he distributed them to those reclining, likewise also as much of the small fishes as they wanted. (John 6:11)

[Question] What did Jesus do, to feed this large crowd?
