

**John 6:27~** **Work, not for the food that perishes, but for the food that remains for life everlasting, which the Son of man will give you, for upon this one the Father, even God, has put his seal of approval.**

**1· So Jesus told them to work not for the food that perishes, like the material provisions he had fed them with the previous day across the lake, but for the food that remains for everlasting life.**

**[Question]** What food then, did Jesus tell them to work for, and what did he mean by this?

**2· This food the Son Of Man could also give them, for God his Father had placed his seal of approval upon his Son, and so his blessing was with him. By saying this, Jesus told the crowds to listen to his teachings, for this was the spiritual food, that would lead them to everlasting life.**

**[Question]** Who would they have to go to, for this spiritual food?

**[Question]** What then, was Jesus telling them to listen carefully to, for what would they gain from doing so?

**3· Although the fig tree itself may not blossom, and there may be no yield on the vines, the work of the olive tree may actually turn out a failure, and the terraces themselves may actually produce no **food**, the flock may actually be severed from the pen, and there may be no herd in the enclosures. (**Habakkuk 3:17**)**

**[Question]** How did Habakkuk show, that he would keep following Yehowah God, despite difficulties?

**4· Whoever drinks from the water that I **will give** him, **will** never get thirsty at all, but the water that I **will give** him, **will** become in him, a fountain of water, bubbling up to impart **everlasting** life. (**John 4:14**)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus state, would be the case of one who drank the water he gave to them, and what would this was become within them, as they told others the Good News of God?

**5· This means **everlasting life**, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true **God**, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (**John 17:3**)**

**[Question]** What means everlasting life to mankind?

- 6· For the wages sin pays is death, but the gift **God gives, is everlasting life, by Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)**

**[Question]** What are the wages that sin pays?

**[Question]** What is the free gift of God, and through whom, does it come?

- 7· He committed himself to Yehowah. Let Him provide him with escape! Let him deliver him, since he **has** taken delight in him! **(Psalms 22:8)**

**[Question]** What did men say mockingly to Jesus, since he trusted in Yehowah God alone?

- 8· Look! Also, there was a voice from the heavens that said; This is my **Son**, the beloved, whom I have approved. **(Matthew 3:17)**

**[Question]** What vision was present when Jesus was baptized, and where did it come forth from, and what did it say?

- 9· Men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus the Nazarene, a **man** publicly shown by **God** to you, through powerful works and portents and signs, that **God** did through him in your midst, just as you yourselves know. **(Acts of Apostles 2:22)**

**[Question]** How did Yehowah God make his son manifest to Israel?

- 10· For he received from **God** the **Father**, honor and glory, when words such as these were borne to him by the magnificent glory; This is my son, my beloved, whom I myself have approved. **(2 Peter 1:17)**

**[Question]** How did Yehowah God make three of Jesus' disciples know for a certainty, that Jesus was the Son of God?

- 11· Do not toil to gain riches. Cease from your own understanding. **(Proverbs 23:4)**

**[Question]** What should men not toil solely for?

**[Question]** What should men not trust in?

- 12· What profit does a **man** have in all his hard work at which he works hard under the sun? **(Ecclesiastes 1:3)**

**[Question]** What did the congregator ask, about all the hard works men do in life?

- 13· **And this too is a grave calamity. Exactly as one **has** come, so one **will** go away. What profit is there to the one who keeps working hard for the wind? (**Ecclesiastes 5:16**)**

**[Question]** What did the congregator see as a grave calamity, for how must all go away in death?

- 14· **Look! My servant, on whom I keep fast hold! My chosen one, whom my soul **has** approved! I have **put** my spirit in him. Justice to the nations, is what he **will** bring forth. (**Isaiah 42:1**)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God show, that he would make known through his Messianic servant, and what would he bring forth to the nations?

- 15· **And your **food** that you **will** eat **will** be by weight, twenty shekels a day. From time to time you **will** eat it. (**Ezekiel 4:10**)**

**[Question]** What was the Son Of Man told to eat day by day in measured amounts?

- 16· **In that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, I shall take you, O Zerubbabel, the son of Shealtiel, my servant, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly set you as a **seal** ring, because you are the one whom I have chosen, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (**Haggai 2:23**)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God set Zerubbabel as among his people?

- 17· **For, look! The stone that I have **put** before Joshua! Upon the one stone there are seven eyes. Here I am engraving its engraving, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I **will** take away the error of that land in one day. (**Zechariah 3:9**)**

**[Question]** What David Yehowah God prophesy, through Zechariah, that he would take away from his people in one day?

- 18· **In answer the Lord said to her; Martha, Martha, you are anxious and disturbed about many things. (**Luke 10:41**)**

**[Question]** How did Jesus feel, when Martha was overcome, by tending to a large meal for him and his disciples?

- 19· **A few things, though, are needed, or just one. For her part, Mary chose the good portion, and it **will** not be taken away from her. (Luke 10:42)**

**[Question]** How did Jesus commend Martha's sister teacher Mary for taking a different course, a spiritual one?

- 20· **According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may **give** them **everlasting life**. (John 17:2)**

**[Question]** What does Jesus impart to all the ones God has given him as disciples?

- 21· **And I saw another angel ascending from the sunrising, having a **seal** of the living **God**, and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea. (Revelation 7:2)**

**[Question]** What sealing work is shown in the Revelation vision, that is still ongoing today, and what must wait upon its completion?
