John 6:29~ In answer Jesus said to them; This is the work of God, that you exercise faith in him whom that One sent forth.

1. So Jesus told them plainly, that the work of God, was to listen to the one God sent forth, and to put faith in him. Jesus himself was this one.

2. They said; Believe on the Lord Jesus, and you will get saved, you and your household. (Acts of Apostles 16:31)

[Question] What must men believe in, to gain salvation?

3. Indeed, this is his commandment, that we have faith in the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and be loving one another, just as he gave us commandment. (1 John 3:23)

[Question] What is the commandment we have received from Yehowah God?

4. I know him, because I am a representative from him, and that One sent me forth. (John 7:29)

[Question] Why could Jesus state, that he knew Yehowah God, and what he wanted from mankind?

5. Jesus said to them; If God were your Father, you would love me, for from God I came forth and am here. Neither have I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (John 8:42)

[Question] Where did Jesus come forth from, and so why should men have accepted him?

6. True, I knew that you always hear me, but on account of the crowd standing around I spoke, in order, that they might believe that you sent me forth. (John 11:42)

[Question] What did Jesus want men to understand and believe, when he resurrected Lazarus from the dead?

7. On the other hand, to the man that does not work, but puts faith in him, who declares the ungodly one righteous, his faith is counted as righteousness. (Romans 4:5)
