John 6:31~ Our forefathers ate the manna in the wilderness, just as it is written: He gave them bread from heaven to eat.

1. So they quoted to Jesus, that their forefathers ate the manna in the wilderness, which was a sign from God to them, for he gave them bread from heaven to eat.

[Question] What then, did these ones show to Jesus, that Moses had done to feed them in the wilderness?

[Question] Yet, what had Jesus just done for these men, without them seeing the correlation?

When the sons of Israel got to see it, they began to say to one another; What is it? For they did not know what it was. Hence Moses said to them; It is the bread that Yehowah has given you for food. (Exodus 16:15)

[Question] How did the Israelites feel when the manna fell upon the ground each day, and how did Moses explain what it was?

3. Incidentally, the manna was like coriander seed, and its look was like the look of bdellium gum. (Numbers 11:7)

[Ouestion] What did the manna look and taste like?

4. And bread from heaven you gave them for their hunger, and waters out of the crag you brought forth to them, for their thirst, and you went on to say to them to enter and possess the land, that you had lifted your hand in an oath to give to them. (Nehemiah 9:15)

[Question] How did Nehemiah in his prayer, show how Yehowah God had cared for his people Israel in the wilderness?

5' Your forefathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and yet, died. (John 6:49)

[Question] What did Jesus show, about the men who ate the manna there in the wilderness, under Moses?

6. And all ate the same spiritual food. (1 Corinthians 10:3)

[Question] What spiritual food does Paul here refer to, that the Israelites ate in the wilderness?

7. And he kept raining upon them manna to eat, and the grain

of heaven he gave to them. (Psalms 78:24)

[Question] What did Yehowah God, through Moses, rain down upon his people Israel to eat there in the wilderness?

8. They asked, and he proceeded to bring quails, and with bread from heaven he kept satisfying them. (Psalms 105:40)

[Question] How did Yehowah God also satisfy his people with meat?

9. Then Yehowah said to Moses; Here I am raining down bread for you from the heavens, and the people must go out and pick up each his amount day for day, in order, that I may put them to the test, as to whether they will walk in my Law, or not. (Exodus 16:4)

[Question] How did the Israelites there in the wilderness have to depend daily upon this food from heaven to keep living?

10" Who fed you with manna in the wilderness, which your fathers had not known, in order to humble you, and in order to put you to the test, so as to do you good in your afterdays. (Deuteronomy 8:16)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God feed his people manna there in the wilderness?
