1· Then Jesus revealed, that the true bread of heaven, was the one who came down out of heaven, and who gives life to the people of the world. Jesus himself was that one.

[Question] Who then, did Jesus reveal was the true bread from heaven, and what did he give to prolong the life of the people?

2· Incidentally, the manna was like coriander seed, and its look was like the look of bdellium gum. (Numbers 11:7)

[Question] What did the manna look and taste like?

3· Therefore the Jews began to murmur at him because he said; I am the bread that came down from heaven. (John 6:41)

[Question] How did the Jews feel, when Jesus told them, that he was the true bread from heaven?

4· I am the bread of life. (John 6:48)

[Question] What did Jesus call himself?

5· Because there is one loaf, we, although many, are one body, for we are all partaking of that one loaf. (1 Corinthians 10:17)

[Question] What does the partaking of one loaf at the Memorial, symbolize for anointed Christians?

6· The first man is out of the earth and made of dust, the second man is out of heaven. (1 Corinthians 15:47)

[Question] What is the first man out of, and made from, and how is Jesus different?
