

John 6:37~ **Everything the Father gives me will come to me, and the one that comes to me, I will by no means drive away.**

- 1· **Jesus then showed, that everything that the Father had given to him would be drawn to him and come to him. Also that anyone who did come to him, he would by no means drive away.**

[Question] Who then, would truly be drawn to Jesus and his ministry?

[Question] How would Jesus then treat all those, that the Father brought other him for salvation?

- 2· **Come to me, all you who are toiling and loaded down, and I will refresh you. (Matthew 11:28)**

[Question] What did Jesus invite his disciples to do, and how would they then come to feel in his service?

- 3· **I have made your name manifest to the men you gave me out of the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have observed your word. (John 17:6)**

[Question] Whose name did Jesus Christ make manifest to his disciples, that the Jews were afraid to speak, and how did Jesus' disciples follow him?

- 4· **Incline your ear and come to me. Listen, and your soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with you people, an indefinitely lasting covenant, respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Isaiah 55:3)**

[Question] What free food and drink, does Yehowah God tell the people to seek, through the prophet Isaiah, respecting what faithful promises of his made earlier?

- 5· **And I give them everlasting life, and they will by no means ever be destroyed, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)**

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that he would give to them, and what would be their final outcome?

- 6· **According, as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life. (John 17:2)**

[Question] What authority does Jesus have over all flesh, and what will he give the whole number, whom Yehowah God brings to him?

- 7· **Therefore welcome one another, just as the Christ also welcomed us, with glory to God in view. (Romans 15:7)**

[Question] How should anointed Christians welcome one another, in imitation of whom?

- 8· **They went out from us, but they were not of our sort. For if they had been of our sort, they would have remained with us. But they went out, that it might be shown up, that not all are of our sort. (1 John 2:19)**

[Question] Who broke off from true Christianity even in the apostle Paul's day, and what group has that become today?
