4. For if we have become united with him in the likeness of his death, we shall certainly also be united with him in the likeness of his resurrection. (Romans 6:5)

[Question] What hope, do those who have become united with Jesus in the likeness of his death, bear?

5. In order, that the word might be fulfilled which he said; Of those whom you have given me, I have not lost a single one. (John 18:9)

[Question] Who did Jesus preserve, and in accord with whose word to him?
