For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son, and exercises faith in him, should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day.

1. Then Jesus revealed, that the will of Yehowah God was for everyone who beholds the Son, and puts his faith in him, to have everlasting life. Then Jesus shows, that to all such ones, that they can look forward to a resurrection to life on the last day.

[Question] What did Jesus then reveal, was the hope to which God had called them all, and what can they all look forward to?

2. And I give them everlasting life, and they will by no means ever be destroyed, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that he would give to them, and who then, would not be able to get ahold of them?

3. And as for you yourself, go toward the end, and you will rest, but you will stand up for your lot at the end of the days. (Daniel 12:13)

[Question] What was faithful Daniel told to do in death, with what hope for the future?

4. Martha said to him; I know he will rise in the resurrection on the last day. (John 11:24)

[Question] What hope did Martha state, that she had in the future?

5. Because he has set a day in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness, by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men, in that, he has resurrected him from the dead. (Acts of Apostles 17:31)

[Question] Who has Yehowah God put forth to judge the inhabited earth, and what guarantee has he given, that this judgment will take place?

6 Because the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a commanding call, with an archangel's voice and with God's trumpet, and those who are dead in union with Christ will rise first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16)

[Question] From where will Jesus descend, and what will he say to bring the chosen ones to life first?

7. And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. But another scroll was opened, it is the scroll of life. And the dead were judged out of those things written in the scrolls, according to their deeds. (Revelation 20:12)

[Question] Where are the dead shown to be, and what then happens before them?

[Question] How then, will the dead be judged, according to what?

8. Moses at once made a serpent of copper and placed it upon the signal pole, and it did occur, that if a serpent had bitten a man and he gazed at the copper serpent, he then kept alive. (Numbers 21:9)

[Question] How did Moses show prophetically, how the Christ must be raised up among mankind, for them to gain life or salvation?

9. And there will be many of those asleep in the ground of dust who will wake up, these to indefinitely lasting life, and those to reproaches, and to indefinitely lasting abhorrence.

(Daniel 12:2)

[Question] What then, will many wake up to, and what will the resurrection of many others lead to for them?

10" For God loved the world so much, that he gave his onlybegotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

[Question] How is the great love of Yehowah God for mankind made manifest, and to what end purpose?

11. Most truly I say to you, he that hears my word, and believes him that sent me has everlasting life, and he does not come into judgment, but has passed over from death to life. (John 5:24)

[Question] Who did Jesus show has everlasting life, and what have such ones passed over from and to, avoiding what?

12. He that feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood, has

everlasting life, and I shall resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:54)

[Question] What did Jesus say, that men would have to feed upon, symbolically, to have everlasting life, and what would he do for them later?

13. Also, I know that his commandment means everlasting life. Therefore the things I speak, just as the Father has told me them, so I speak them. (John 12:50)

[Question] Why did Jesus tell them the things he told them, for what did he know about his Father's word?

14. Nevertheless, the reason why I was shown mercy was, that by means of me as the foremost case, Christ Jesus might demonstrate all his long-suffering, for a sample of those, who are going to rest their faith on him for everlasting life. (1 Timothy 1:16)

[Question] What did the apostle Paul serve as the foremost example of?

15. Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus through God's will, according to the promise of the life, that is in union with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 1:1)

[Question] What promise from Yehowah God comes to those in union with Jesus Christ?

16. Furthermore, the world is passing away, and so is its desire, but he that does the will of God, remains forever. (1 John 2:17)

[Question] What happens to this present worldly system of things, but what happens to those who do the will of Yehowah God?

17. And when I saw him, I fell as dead at his feet. And he laid his right hand upon me and said; Do not be fearful. I am the First and the Last. (Revelation 1:17)

[Question] What is Jesus described as in the Revelation vision?
