John 6:44~ No man can come to me unless the Father, who sent me, draws him, and I will resurrect him in the last day.

1. Jesus then told the crowds that no man can come to him unless the Father draws such a one to him. All such ones are the ones that he would resurrect at the last day.

[Question] Can any man become a disciple of Jesus, unless Yehowah God calls him to become such?

[Question] What will Jesus then do, for all true disciples on the last day?

2. So he went on to say; This is why I have said to you, no one can come to me, unless it is granted him by the Father. (John 6:65)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that no man could do, unless Yehowah God granted him to do it?

3. However, we are obligated to thank God always for you, brothers loved by Yehowah, because God selected you from the beginning for salvation, by sanctifying you with spirit, and by your faith in the truth. (2 Thessalonians 2:13)

[Question] What did Paul also show, that Yehowah God selected from the beginning, and how did he show his approval of them?

4. Martha said to him; I know he will rise in the resurrection on the last day. (John 11:24)

[Question] What faith did Martha have, and express to Jesus in the future after death?

5' By this undeserved kindness, indeed, you have been saved through faith. And this not owing to you, it is God's gift. (Ephesians 2:8)

[Question] Through what are anointed Christians saved, and how does this gift come to them?
