Not that any man has seen the Father, except he who is from God. This one has seen the Father.

1. Then Jesus showed that this knowing of Yehowah was not a seeing of him, for no man except his Son had seen him. Jesus himself in his pre-human existence had seen God, but no other man that had ever lived had seen God.

[Question] What did Jesus show, that this knowing Yehowah, did not mean?

2. And he added; You are not able to see my face, because no man may see me and yet live. (Exodus 33:20)

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell Moses, about any man being able to see God?

3. All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the Son, and anyone, to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Matthew 11:27)

[Question] Who knows the Father the best, and who is the son willing to reveal the Father to?

4. All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and who the Son is no one knows, but the Father, and who the Father is, no one knows, but the Son, and he, to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Luke 10:22)

[Question] Who knows the most about the Father, and who knows the Son the best?

[Question] Who only can anointed Christians get to know either of them?

5. No man has seen God at any time, the only-begotten god who is in the bosom position with the Father, is the one that has explained him. (John 1:18)

[Question] Has any man ever seen Yehowah God while a man?

[Question] Who though, knew him in heaven before becoming a man, and what has he done to reveal the Father to mankind?

6. And Yehowah spoke to Moses face to face, just as a man would speak to his fellow. When he returned to the camp,

his minister Joshua, the son of Nun, as attendant, would not withdraw from the midst of the tent. (Exodus 33:11)

[Question] How did Yehowah God speak to Moses, and did this mean that Moses ever saw Yehowah God's face, or what was the situation between them?

7. Also, the Father who sent me, has himself borne witness about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his figure. (John 5:37)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his Jewish listeners, that they had never seen nor heard?

8. At no time has anyone beheld God. If we continue loving one another, God remains in us, and his love is made perfect in us. (1 John 4:12)

[Question] Has any human seen God at any time?

[Question] How does the love of Yehowah God remain within us, and how is it made perfect or complete?
