John 6:49~ Your forefathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and yet, died.

1 So Jesus began to reason with them, about the men who ate of the manna, there in the wilderness, under Moses hand of leadership. They all died despite eating the manna.

[Question] What did Jesus then reason out with these men who trusted in Moses leadership, but not in Jesus' leadership?

[Question] How did all those men end up, even though they ate the manna?

Our forefathers ate the manna in the wilderness, just as it is written: He gave them bread from heaven to eat. (John 6:31)

[Question] How did these Jews retort to Jesus statement, that he was the bread of life?

3. And the sons of Israel ate the manna forty years, until their coming to a land inhabited. The manna was what they ate, until their coming to the frontier of the land of Canaan. (Exodus 16:35)

[Question] How long did the Israelites exist, living solely upon the manna, in an inhospitable land, and when did it stop falling from heaven?

4. Who fed you with manna in the wilderness, which your fathers had not known, in order to humble you, and in order to put you to the test, so as to do you good in your afterdays. (Deuteronomy 8:16)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God thus feed a rebellious and disobedient people this way?
